WHEREAS, the Owner understands and agrees that an adjustment in the impac	ot fees may be
required;

The method of computation of the initial impact fee is set forth by the Authority.

If the consumption of service by the Owner is greater than that stated, the imparadjusted according to the usage at the impact fee rate(s) in effect at the time of the new set forth in the Impact Fee Ordinance.

Owner agrees to pay all impact fees that are due.

Owner hereby understands that impact fees shall be paid in full prior to issuance letter; which is required to obtain a land disturbance permit, building permit or approval of Occupancy.

As set forth in the Impact Fee Ordinance, any future demand placed on the water sewerage facilities in excess of the average demand anticipated at the time of issuance invoice shall be assessed.

Dear Non-Residential Customer,

All non-residential domestic and irrigation services are considered high risk for cross connection and shall be equipped with a testable reduced pressure zone (RPZ) backflow preventer immediately downstream of the water meter. Fire services that contain contaminates shall also be equipped with a RPZ backflow preventer. If you believe that your location is not high risk you may apply for a variance. Please see table below.

Following installation of the appropriate device, an initial test will be performed. Annual testing of these devices will be required in accordance with HCWA's Cross Connection Control Program. Tests must be completed by a <u>CERTIFIED</u> backflow tester approved by HCWA. This list can be found at <u>www.hcwa.com</u>. (A list of certified testers can also be provided upon request.)




